## President's Challenge Rules:

- Size Minimum 30" x 30", Maximum 36" x 36"
- Must be made using Library and or Reading theme.
- The quilt is **yours!** But we would like to borrow it for the Annual Lakeshore Library Exhibit scheduled for the months of September and October 2018.
- Your *finished* quilt should be delivered to the August 25, 2018 meeting
  Finished = quilted and bound with a 4 inch sleeve and label attached.

**LIBRARY DEFINITION**: a building or room containing collections of books, periodicals, and sometimes films and recorded music for people to read, borrow, or refer to.

**<u>TITLES</u>**: Books, movies, poems, songs, and comic books.

Some examples: I Know Why the Cage Bird Sings, The Jungle Book, To Kill A Mockingbird, Ain't No Mountain High Enough, A Raisin In the Sun, Black Panther, The Audacity of Hope, Selma, Notorious RBG, Letters from the Birmingham Jail, I Have a Dream, The Fire Next Time, Notes of a Native Son, Invisible Man, My Arms are too Short to Box with God.

**VALUE**: a public place to read, gain knowledge, learn, conduct research, collect information, get inspired, socialize, have fun AND dream!

Have fun with the challenge – make it traditional or make it artistic ... make it your statement!!
