Cutting:

January: Wishing Ring	6 ¼" Block	12 1/2" Block
Fabric 1	(4) 2 ¼" x 2 ¼" squares	(4) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares
	(4) 1 ¾" x 1 ¾" squares	(4) 3" x 3" squares
Fabric 2	(8) 1 ¾" x 1 ¾" squares	(8) 3" x 3" squares
Background	(4) 2 ¼" x 2 ¼" squares	(4) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares
	(5) 1 ¾" x 1 ¾" squares	(5) 3" x 3" squares

Make the Half-Square Triangles


1. Begin by drawing a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each 3 $1/2'' \times 3 1/2'' (2 \frac{1}{4}'' \times 2 \frac{1}{4}'')$ background square.

2. Next, make half-square triangle units using a $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{1}{2} (2 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{1}{4})$ Fabric 1 square and a $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{1}{2} (2 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{1}{4})$ background square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ from either side of drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and trim to measure $3'' \times 3'' (1 \frac{3}{4}'' \times 1 \frac{3}{4})$. Make eight. 3. Now just lay out the 8 half-square triangles along with the fabric one, fabric two, and background squares as shown in the block diagram.

- 4. Sew the blocks in each row together, pressing seams in one direction.
- 5. Sew the rows together and press seams in one direction!



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
