20x20 Challenge Rules

- Size = 20 inches by 20 inches
- **Encouraged ... but not required**: A piece of African fabric can be tiny and placed anywhere on the quilt (front or back).
- The quilt is **yours!** But we would like to borrow it for AAQGO's 20th Anniversary Celebration. Exhibits will be scheduled beginning May 2020 possibly continuing until 2021. Dates and venues are TBD. **NOTE**: Early bird finishers are encouraged & welcome since the first "mini" exhibit could be at our February 2020 Black History Month Family Workshop! Stay tuned for updates.
- **DEADLINE**: Your finished quilt should be delivered to the **April 2020** meeting. Finished = quilted and bound with a 4 inch sleeve and label attached.
