Quarter Triangles Tutorial – Ernie - Education

Quarter triangles are easy if you know how to make half square triangles. We have gone over half square triangles at previous meetings. I hope this training will assist you in a basic way to make quarter triangles.

The **rule is cut your squares 1** $\frac{1}{4}$ " larger than what your finished size unit will be. Example: if you want a 4" finished unit, cut your squares 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ ". A light and contrast print.

- > Take (2) square units (your size unit), place RST,
- Mark a diagonal line on the back side of lighter fabric (see examples),
- Sew a scant ¼" from that center line you just marked (sew on both sides of that line),
- Cut apart, press (this is your half square triangle)

Next – for your quarter triangle,

- place your two half square triangles RST facing opposite sides (see example), draw a diagonal line down the middle,
- sew a scant ¼" from that line on both sides
- cut apart and press

Examples:









Diagonal line/sew both sides

Cut in half - ½ square triangle

Opposite sides RST, draw diagonal line Placement - sew both sides of line



Cut apart & press open – this is your qtr triangle
