## Quarter Triangles Tutorial -Ernie - Education

Quarter triangles are easy if you know how to make half square triangles. We have gone over half square triangles at previous meetings. I hope this training will assist you in a basic way to make quarter triangles.

The rule is cut your squares $11 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ " larger than what your finished size unit will be. Example: if you want a 4 " finished unit, cut your squares $51 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$. A light and contrast print.
> Take (2) square units (your size unit), place RST,
> Mark a diagonal line on the back side of lighter fabric (see examples),
$>$ Sew a scant $1 / 4 \prime \prime$ from that center line you just marked (sew on both sides of that line),
$>$ Cut apart, press (this is your half square triangle)

Next - for your quarter triangle,
> place your two half square triangles RST facing opposite sides (see example), draw a diagonal line down the middle,
$>$ sew a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from that line on both sides
$>$ cut apart and press
