OUR RECIPIENTS:

- CALICO is the Child Abuse, Listening, Interviewing, and Coordination center serving Alameda County. CALICO achieves justice and healing for abused children, age 2 to 17, by bringing together law enforcement officers, child welfare workers, prosecutors, and other professionals to investigate abuse allegations and elicit testimony from children. CALICO serves approximately 600 – 800 children each year.
- 2) **HIGHLAND HOSPITAL NEO-NATAL NURSERY** provides intensive care unit (ICU) services for newborns whose mothers have no or limited financial means (typically new immigrants, currently incarcerated, homeless, etc.).

- Receiving blankets, size 30"x32", 100% cotton flannel, <u>OR</u>
- Baby quilts, size 36"x36", 100% cotton
- FOR CALICO
 - Quilts any size larger than 36"x36" up to twin size. 100% cotton preferred.
 - Blankets, fleece. Single layer with fringe cut or double layer, fringe cut and tied.
 - Tote bags. Size 16" W by 18" L. Plus or minus 1 2 inches = OKAY!
 - Fleece Scarves lively colors, sports team, etc. Single or double layer.
 - **NOTE**: Pillowcases are NO LONGER needed and have been deleted from this list.
