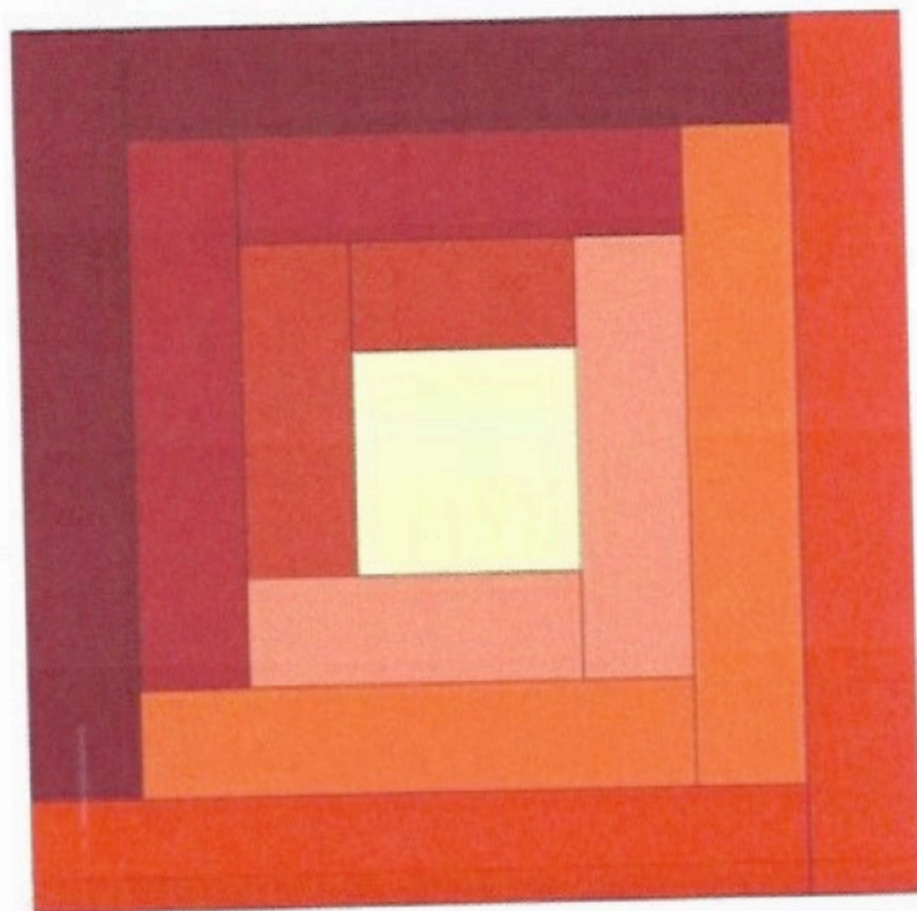

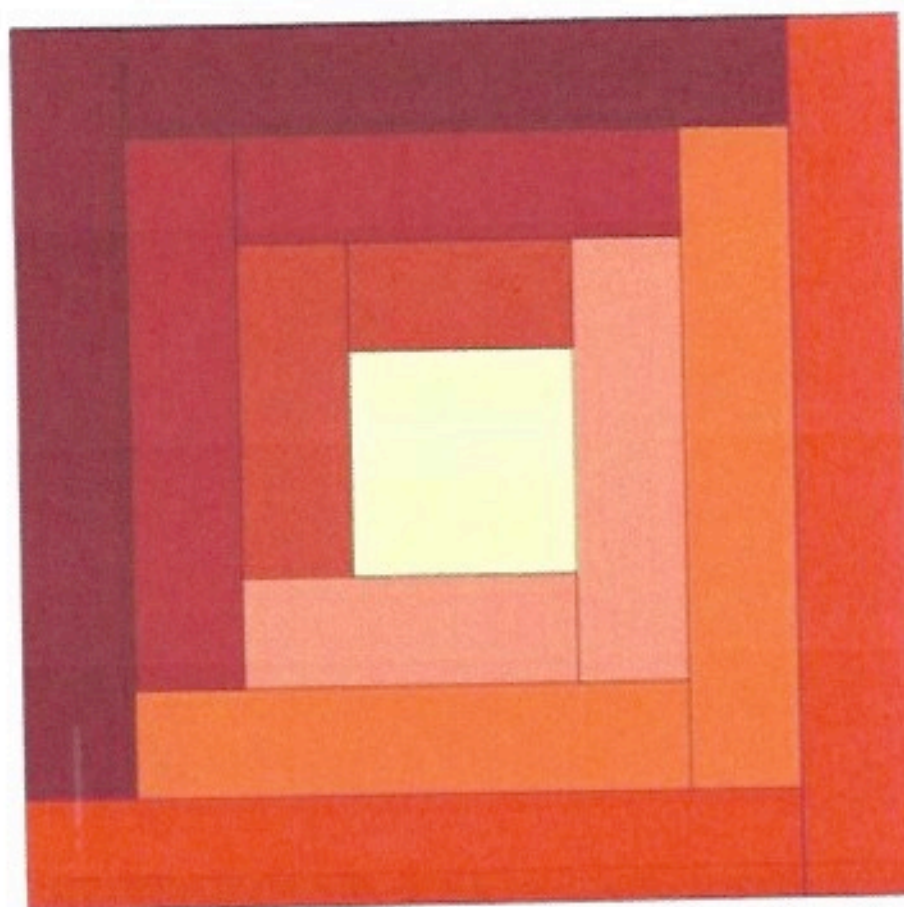

Finished Block Size 12 X 12 inches



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

HONEYCOMB FABRIC:

Cut one square 3.5 X 3.5 inches. (Label H)

MAROON FABRIC:

Cut a 2 inch strip. Cut one log 2 X 11 inches. (Label A - Dark)

Cut one log 2 X 9.5 inches. (Label B - Dark)

SCARLET FABRIC:

Cut a 2 inch strip. Cut one log 2 X 8 inches. (Label D - Dark)

Cut one log 2 X 6.5 inches. (Label E - Dark)

PAPRIKA FABRIC:

Cut a 2 inch strip. Cut one log 2 X 5 inches. (Label F - Dark)

Cut one log 2 X 3.5 inches. (Label G - Dark)

APRICOT FABRIC:

Cut a 2 inch strip. Cut one log 2 X 6.5 inches. (Label E - Light)

Cut one log 2 X 5 inches. (Label F - Light)

DARE DEVIL FABRIC:

Cut a 2 inch strip. Cut one log 2 X 9.5 inches. (Label B - Light)

Cut one log 2 X 8 inches. (Label D - Light)

BURNT ORANGE FABRIC:

Cut a 2 inch strip. Cut one log 2 X 12.5 inches. (Label C - Light)

Cut one log 2 X 11 inches. (Label A - Light)

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Refer to block diagram above for colour references.

Press away from centre for all seams

With the centre H square, attach G-Dark-Paprika to the top side..

Attach F-Dark Paprika to left side.

Attach F-Light Apricot to bottom. Next stitch E-Light Apricot on the right side of block.
This completes your first inner square.

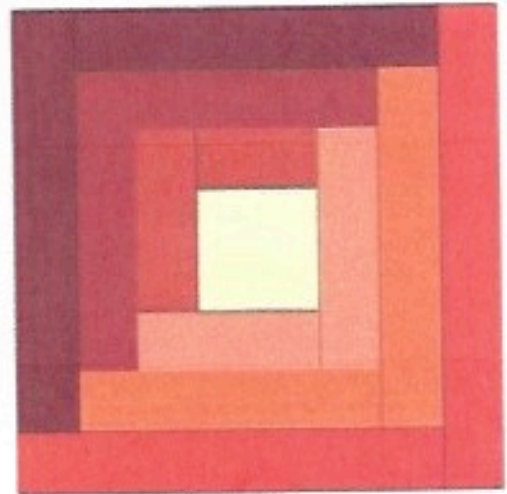
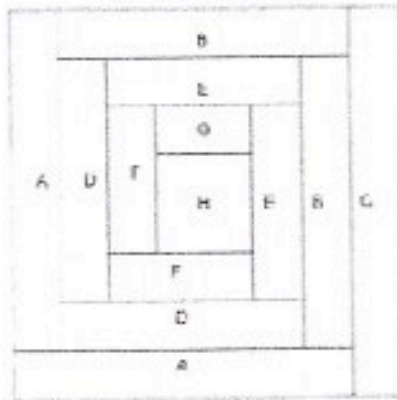
Round two begins with E-Dark Scarlet attach to top side of block. Next is D-Dark Scarlet on left edge of block.

Attach D-Light Dare Devil on bottom, then B-Light Dare Devil on right side of block. Continue pressing seams to outside of block.

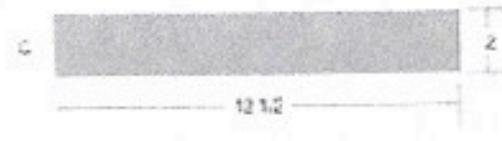
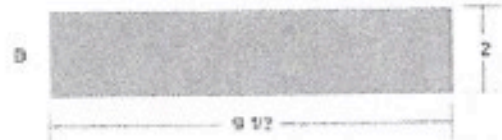
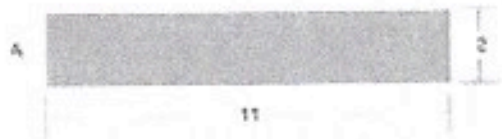
The final round of logs will begin with Dark-B Maroon on top of the block, Dark A Maroon on left. Add the light A on to the bottom of the block and finish with Light C on the right hand side.

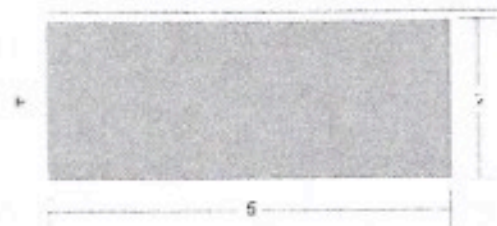

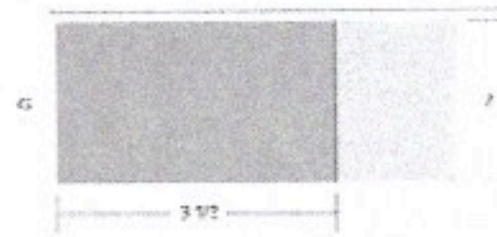

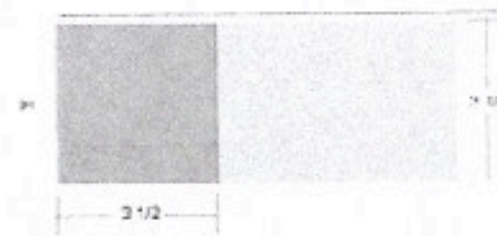

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS - SINGLE BLOCK

You will need seven fabrics for a single block.

We used a 2 inch strip of the following fabrics:

Maroon

Scarlet

Paprika

Apricot

Dare Devil

Burnt Orange

AND

3.5 inch square - Honeycomb (centre square)
