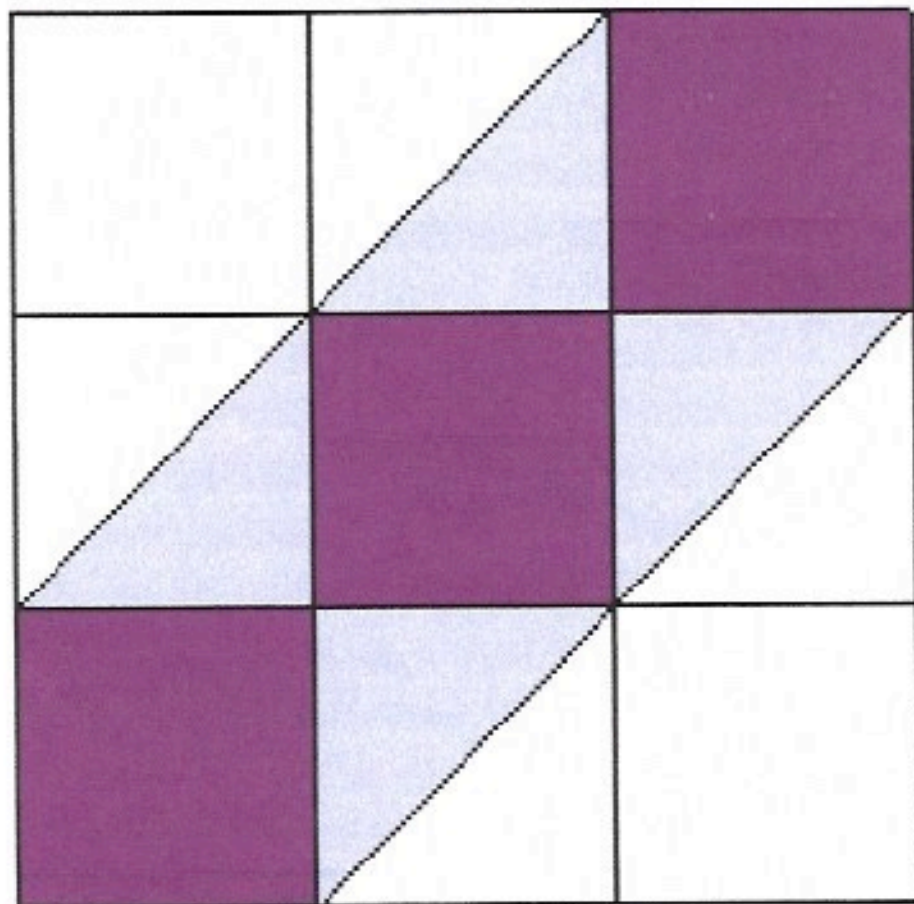




Block #1 - Road To California

Finished Block Size 12 X 12 inches



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WHITE FABRIC:

Cut a 4.5 inch strip. Sub cut 2 squares, 4.5 X 4.5 inches. Label these A.

Cut a 4 7/8 inch strip. Sub cut 2 squares, 5×5 4-7/8 X 4-7/8 inches. Cut each on the diagonal to yield 4 triangles. Label these B.

GRAPE FABRIC:

Cut a 4.5 inch strip. Sub cut 3 squares, 4.5 X 4.5 inches. Label these A.

SACHET FABRIC:

Cut a 4 7/8 inch strip. Sub cut 2 squares, 4 7/8 X 4 7/8 inches. Cut each on the diagonal to yield 4 triangles. Label these B.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Begin by piecing a White B piece to a Sachet B piece. — white 5x5 + color 5x5
Make four of these Half Square Triangle Units. —
Press towards the darker fabric.

Refer to the block diagram above and lay out your patches as shown.

Stitch the rows of your block together.

Press the top and bottom row to the right.

Press the middle row to the left.

Join all three rows to finish your block.

Whats Next?

I made four blocks total and joined those together to make a square centrepiece.

Lastly I made four little four patches and used those as cornerstones for an outer border.

This will create a Table Topper that measures 32 X 32 inches.

I have included yardage requirements and finishing instructions below in case you would like to do the same.

You will need three fabrics for a single block.

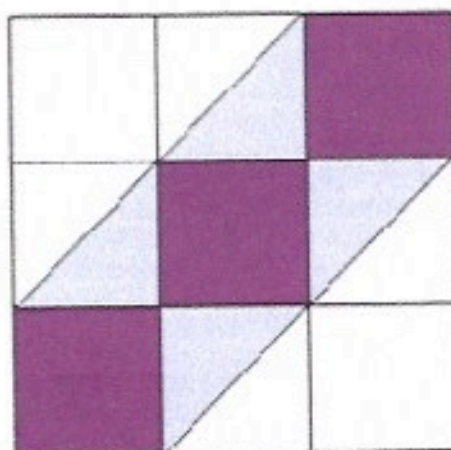
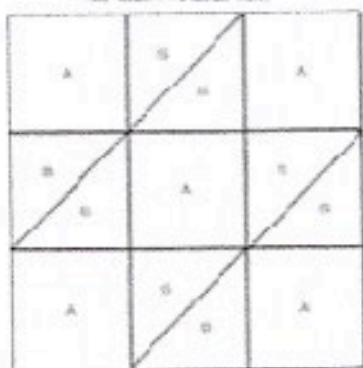

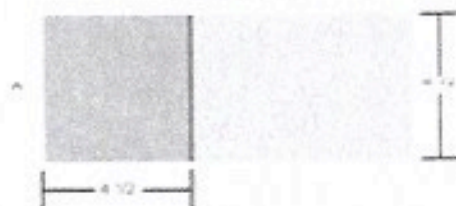

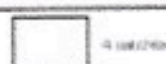
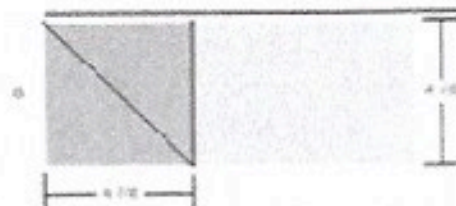
Two (2) 1/2 inch seam



Cutting Diagrams

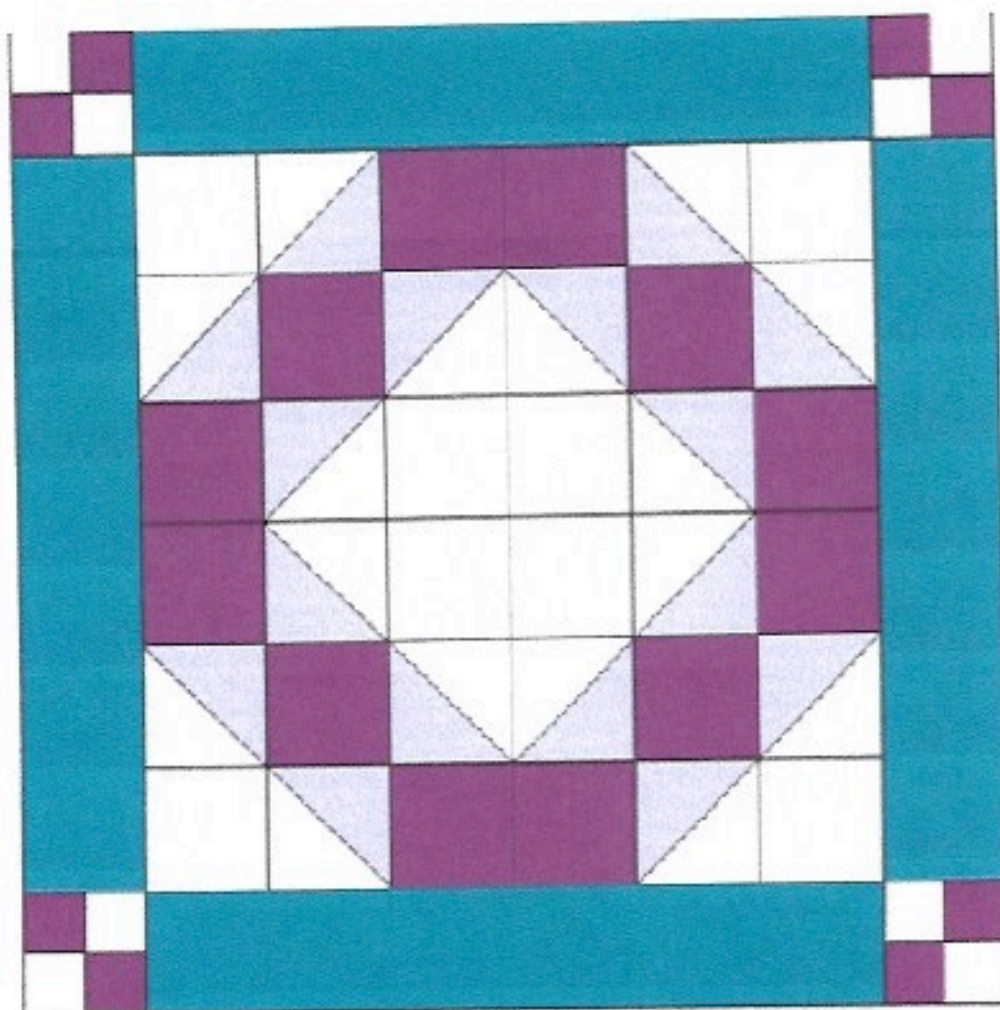






Piecing Chart



Road To Dal Table Topper

Color	Quantity (# of pieces)	Size (inches)	Fabric name (if any)
	22	5" x 5"	Gold
	20	5" x 5"	25 161 grass
	16	5" x 5"	26 104 peridot
	4	2" x 2"	710-11710 snow

INSTRUCTIONS

Piece four of the Road To California Block as instructed above.
Join blocks in pairs, then attach the two rows together to create a square centre.

Cut a strip of white 2.5 X 20 inches.
Cut a strip of grape 2.5 X 20 inches.

Stitch the two strips together and press to the darker fabric.

Sub cut 8 rectangles (2.5X 4.5 inches) from the pieced strip.
Create four patch blocks from your pieced rectangles.
These will be the cornerstones of your border.

Cut 4 strips of Marine Fabric (4.5 inches X 24.5)

Add a marine strip to the top and bottom of your four Road to California blocks.

Add a cornerstone to each end of the two remaining border pieces. Press towards border.

Add the cornerstone borders to the last two sides of your quilt top.

Now its time to baste, quilt as desired, bind and send Bradie a picture! ;)
