

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Block #3 - Bear Paw

Finished Block Size 12 X 12 inches

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS - SINGLE BLOCK

White Fabric - 5 inch X 22 inch strip Brown Fabric - 10 inch X 22 inch strip

I used a variety of browns. Here are those specs: 2 Brown Fabrics - Each 5 X 5 inches 1 Brown - 8.5 inch X 8.5 inch

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS


White Fabric - Cut strip to 4 7/8 inches wide. Subcut 2 squares (4 7/8 X 4 7/8 inches). Cut each square once on diagonal to yield 4 triangles.


Cut one white square 4.5 inch x 4.5 inch.


Cut one brown square 8.5 inch x 8.5 inch.
Cut 2 brown squares 4 7/8 x 4 7/8 inch.
Cut each in half on diagonal to yield a total of four brown triangles.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Begin by piecing a white triangle to a brown triangle. Press to brown fabric. Make four of these units.

Layout your patches as shown in the block diagram.

Piece together the top row. This will be the single white square plus two brown HST.

Piece the two remaining brown HST units to each other using the block diagram for reference. Next piece that unit to the large brown square. Press towards the triangle units.

Lastly add the top row to the large unit just created. Press that seam down towards the large brown square.

Your block is complete!




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Block #4 - Snowball Star

Finished Block Size 12 X 12 inches



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Below, you will find cutting and piecing diagrams for a single Snowball Star Block. Please read the entire pattern over before beginning. A quarter inch seam should be used for all piecing.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS - SINGLE BLOCK

White Fabric - 1/4 yard Assorted Red Fabric - 1/4 yard total Assorted Green Fabric - 4 inch X 20 inch

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

White Fabric

Cut strip to 7 1/4 inches. Cut two squares 7 1/4 X 7 1/4 inches. Cut each twice on diagonal for total 6 triangles. Two are for block centre, 4 will be for flying geese units. (You will end up with 8 triangles, put 2 in your scrap pile) Subcut 2 squares (3 7/8 X 3 7/8 inches). Cut each square once on diagonal to yield 4 triangles.

Red Fabric

Cut strip to 7 1/4 inches. Cut one square 7 1/4 X 7 1/4 inches. Cut twice on diagonal to yield four triangles. Two are for block centre, two are for scrap pile. Subcut 2 squares (3 7/8 X 3 7/8 inches). Cut each square once on diagonal to yield 4 triangles.

Green Fabric

Subcut 4 squares (3 7/8 X 3 7/8 inches). Cut each square once on diagonal to yield 8 triangles.
