









Below, you will find cutting and piecing diagrams for a single Chain Star Block. Please read the entire pattern over before beginning. A quarter inch seam should be used for all piecing.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS - SINGLE BLOCK
Royal Purple - 2.5 inch X 30 inch strip
Gold - 3 inch X WOF strip
Snow - 8 inch X WOF strip

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Royal Purple Fabric

A) Cut 10 squares each 2.5 X 2.5 inches.

Gold Fabric

 A) LABEL THESE 'C' - Cut 2 rectangles, each 5 3/8 x 2 5/8 inches. Cut once on diagonal from top right to bottom left to create four triangles. (Reference the cutting diagrams to be sure you are making the diagonal cut accurately.)

B) LABEL THESE 'D' - Cut 2 rectangles, each 5 3/8 x 2 5/8 inches. Cut once on diagonal from top left to bottom right to create four triangles. (Reference the cutting diagrams to be sure you are making the diagonal cut accurately.)


Snow Fabric


- A) Cut 10 squares each 2.5 X 2.5 inches.
- B) Cut a strip 4 3/4 inches wide. Use the 'B' template provided to cut 4 triangles.




Chain Star

Key Block (1/5 actual size)










Chain Star

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS - SINGLE BLOCK SIX

Begin by piecing the four patch units. Piece a snow square to a royal square, press towards purple. Make ten.

Pair those together to make a total of 5 four patch units.

Next lay out a snow triangle with wide bottom edge towards you. Place a C Gold triangle on the left side of triangle. Ensure the top tips of the two pieces are lined up, there will be excess gold at bottom left edge, leave that hanging off. Stitch and press towards gold fabric. Make four of these units.

Using the same type of alignment, piece a D Gold triangle on the right hand side of the snow triangle. Stitch and press towards gold fabric.

Now lay out your four patches and triangle units as shown in block diagram. Watch the placement of four patches to ensure you get the chain effect of the block. Stitch together in rows then join the three rows of the block together.
