

## Crowning Glory

This makes a 12 " block!




\*\* Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block \*\*




Start by marking and cutting the Color 1 2-7/8" x 11-1/2" strip into four 2-7/8" squares. Stack and cut these in half along one diagonal to make eight half square triangles...



Next mark and cut the Color 2 2-1/2" x 10" strip into four 2-1/2" squares...




Cut the Color 3 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip into two 4-7/8" squares. Stack and cut these along one diagonal to make four half square triangles...




Now speed piece the quarter square triangle units, by stacking the Color 1 and Color 2 5-1/4" x 10-1/2" strips right sides together and all edges aligned. On the back of the top strip, lightly mark the 5-1/4" square lines, then mark in the diagonals as shown above. Sew a scant 1/4" above and below the marked diagonals, pivoting at the square lines. Cut these apart on the square lines and on the diagonal lines between the


## Crowning Glory - Page 2



To sew the corner units, using a scant 1/4" seam, sew a Color 1 half square triangle right sides together to the left edge of a Color 2 2-1/2" square. Press seam towards the triangle. Add another Color 1 half square triangle to the upper adjacent edge of the Color 2 square. Again press the seam towards the triangle. Next sew a Color 3 half square triangle to the pieced corner unit. Make four corner units like this. These should measure 4-1/2"...



Now lay out all the units as shown at left, with the Extra Color 3 4-1/2" square as the block's center. Sew together in three horizontal rows, pressing row seams in alternating directions. Join the rows to finish your Crowning Glory Block!

## \*\* Supplies List \*\*

Color 1 Color 1 needs: one 2-7/8" x 11-1/2" strip AND one 5-1/4" x 10-1/2" strip

Color 2 Color 2 needs: one 2-1/2" x 10" strip AND one 5-1/4" x 10-1/2" strip

Color 3 <u>Color 3 needs</u>: one 4-1/2" square AND one 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip
