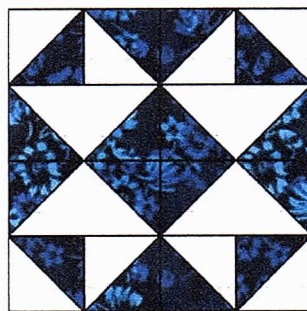

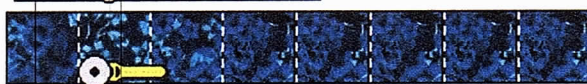

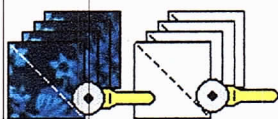

** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **



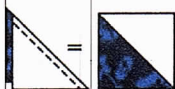
Let's begin by stacking, marking and cutting the Color 1 and Color 2 $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " strips into four $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Then cut the Color 1 $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 28" strip into eight $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares...



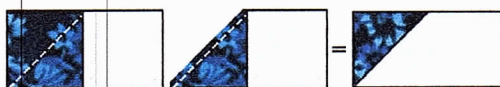
Cut the Color 1 and Color 2 $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares on the diagonals to make eight half square triangles of each...



Then cut your Color 2 $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26" strip into four $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles...



Begin by stacking, edges aligned, a Color 2 and a Color 1 half square triangle. Sew, using a SCANT $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Press seam allowances towards your darker fabric. Make eight of these units. Trim to measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " if needed...

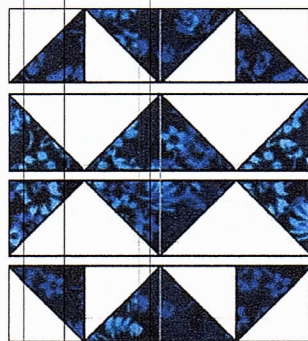


Then, place your Color 1 $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares atop a Color 2 rectangle, with edges aligned and right sides together. Mark a diagonal line on the back of the Color 1 square. Sew along this line, cut off the excess. Press seam towards darker fabric..

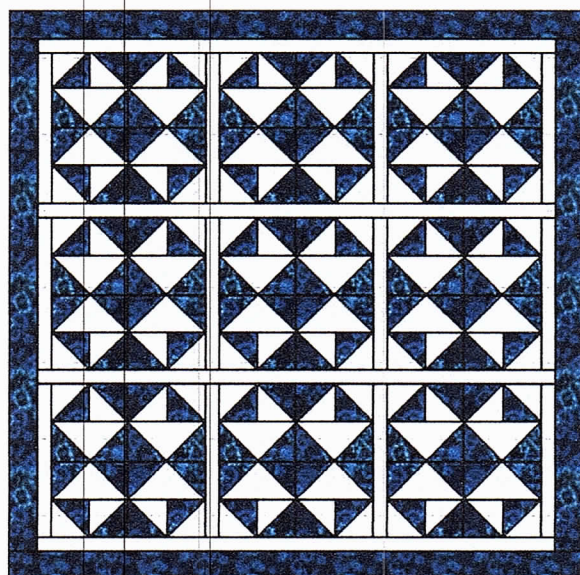


Then repeat the above with another square on the other corner of the Color 2 rectangles. Make four of these units...on to Page 2!

Another Star - Page 2



Now piece the block! Make rows first...row one is made of four half squares...row two equals two of the rectangle units, as does row three...and then row four is made of the remaining half squares...refer to diagram for placement! Lastly...sew your rows together...and press row seams in alternating directions...



Here are three blocks by three with sashings and a simple border!
